2. Venue and Date

The Championship will be held from Sunday 24 to Saturday 30 August 2008
on lake Silvaplana, Switzerland. (at the South end of the lake)

3. Rules

- 3.1 The regatta will be governed by the "rules" as defined in the Racing Rules of Sailing .
- 3.2 Rules of local authorities and of the Segel-Club St. Moritz will apply.
- 3.3 If there is a conflict between languages the English text will prevail.

4. Eligibility

- 4.1 The regatta is open to all boats in accordance with the Musto class rules.
- 4.2 Competitors shall be full members of their national Class Association and shall comply with rule 75.1. For Swiss competitors the amendments of Swiss Sailing to the Eligibility Code will apply.

5. Advertising

- 5.1 Advertising Category C will apply.

6. Entry

- 6.1 Entries shall be submitted on the enclosed Entry Form, duly completed.
The following documents (copy) shall be enclosed:
 - Club membership licence
 - Confirmation of the legitimacy for advertising category C (swiss participants)
 - Confirmation of the third-party liability insurance. (sFr. 1.5 Mio and valid for regatta)

- 6.3 Entry deadline: 24th August 2008

7. Schedule of Races

7.1 Programme:

Sat. 23.8.	12.00 - 18.00	Early bird inspection and registration
Sun. 24.8.	08.00 - 11.00 12.30 h 14.00 h	Inspection and registration Competitor meeting and briefing 13.55 hrs Warning signal for practice race
Mon. 25.8.	10.30 h 12.30 h	Opening ceremony Competitor meeting and briefing, followed by up to three races
Tue. 26.8. to Sat 30.8.	10.00 h	Competitor meeting and briefing, followed by up to three races
Sat. 30.8.	15.30 h	last start possible No warning signal will be made after 15:25

7.2 Scheduled Races:

12 races are scheduled,
of which six races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

- On one day no more than 3 valid races (per boat) will be sailed.

8. Measurement

8.1 On arrival, boats shall first be presented for inspection at the tent next to the Clubhouse. On passing inspection, competitors may then register.

8.2 No new equipment measurement.

9. Courses

The course to be sailed will be announced in the sailing instructions. (handed out at registration)

If the number of entries exceed a manageable level for a single fleet, the organizing authority may decide that boats will race in two fleets, and will state the method of allocation to fleets and scoring on the official notice board.

10. Penalty System

10.1 Rules 44.1 and 44.2 are changed so that only one turn, including one tack and one gybe, is required.

10.2 Decisions of the International Jury will be final as provided in rule 70.4

11. Scoring

11.2 The Low Point Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.

11.2 Scores of the series:

If less than 6 races have been completed, all results shall count.

If six or more races have been completed, the worst score will be excluded.

If nine or more races have been completed, the worst two scores will be excluded.

12. Prizes

- Championship medals for the first 3 boats overall.

- Prizes for the first 10 boats overall

- Prizes for the first 3 each of the classes: Youth / Master / Grand Master

- Memorial prize for each boat

13. Boat Park and Car Park

- 13.1 Tents and campervans are not permitted on the premises
- 13.2 Special parking lots will be marked for the trailers.

Camp sites: at Silvaplana end of the lake and St.Moritz Olympia Schanze.

14. Support boats

- 14.1 On this mountain lake, no support boats are allowed.

15. Social Events

- 15.1 Social events will be published with sailing instructions. A dinner on the mountains is included in the fee. Please announce guests early (or at registration) and include sFr. 50.- p.person.

16. Doping

- 16.1 Random tests by Swiss authority may be expected.

17. Liability and Insurance

- 17.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (See RRS rule 4 - Decision to race). The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
- 17.2 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with adequate cover per event (min. 1,5 Mio CHF) and valid for racing.
